CITY OF GLENNVILLE WATER AND WASTEWATER RATES

State (EPD) and Federal (EPA) governments are adding requirements on municipalities which include conservation measures such as tiered water rates. The best way to ensure everyone is putting forth their best effort to conserve our fresh water resource is through both education and tiered pricing for higher usage. Education can provide ways to conserve and tiered pricing will charge the consumers a higher rate as they use more water which should further encourage consumers to conserve.

Listed below are the base/flat rate prices which remain the same. Below the base rates are the new tiered water rates. These rates are calculated in an effort to produce sufficient funds to maintain and operate the water/sewer system as required by its Bond Resolution. The new tier pricing will take effect with the March water readings, April 1, 2009 billing:
